Family Connections is an evidence-based and systemic mental health consutaltion and professional development model that:

- Builds professional capacity
- · Promotes mental health and social-emotional wellness in young children, their families and providers
- · Deepens professionals' understanding of families facing depression and other adversities

What Do Providers Learn?

- Further enhance mental health consultation services to young children, their families, and early childhood professionals
- Support further professional development regarding social-emotional development and mental health
- Focus on the importance of self-reflection, perspective taking, and self-care for providers and families

- Two days of interactive, learner-centered training
- Family Connections and Tell Me A Story training modules demonstrated through presentations, case vignettes, and interactive exercises
- Three post-training group mentoring calls
- Small class sizes that enhance learning outcomes
